Features a king-sized bed with mosquito nest and two single bed in a separate room





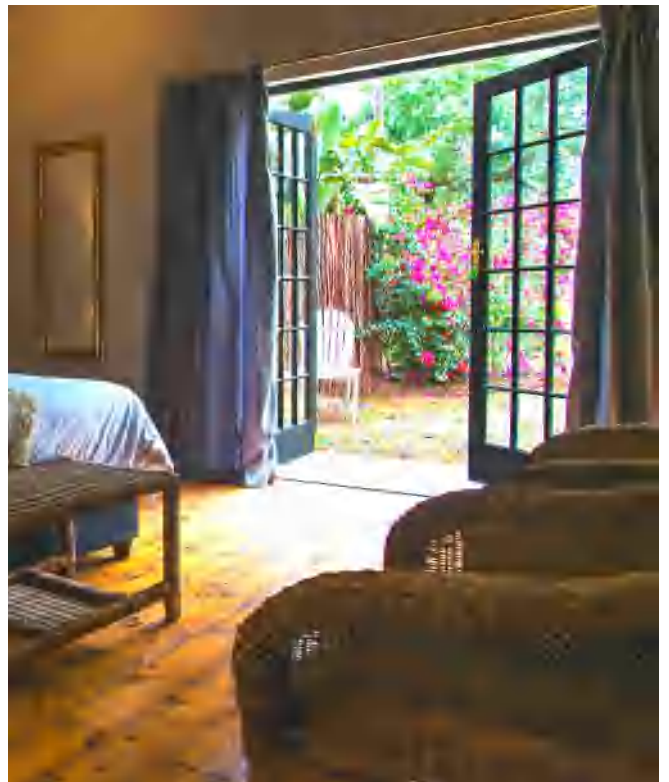

## *Spot the Big 5!*

Our rangers will take you to Addo Elephant National Park, only 10 minutes drive from the property, for a full-day or half-day game drive experience.

Addo Elephant National Park is situated in the dense valley of the Sundays River region. The park offers a memorable wildlife experience and is home to the Big 5, namely Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, Lion and Leopard.

### *Full-day tour - R1950 pp\**

From 8am to 6pm

R1350 child rate - under 13 years old

Tour includes coffee break, braai lunch and park entrance fees.

### *Half-day tour - R1200 pp\**

Morning (8am-1pm) or afternoon (1:30pm-6pm)
